



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS A BRACKET?

A bracket is comprised of teams that have qualified to participate in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. The single-elimination tournament results in two teams competing in the Championship Game on Monday, April 6, 2026. To fill out your bracket, simply select the teams that you think will win each game during the tournament up to the Championship Game. If you are a basketball novice, you can use either our PICK FOR ME button to fill out your bracket with randomly selected teams or our FAVORITES button to fill out your bracket with the highest-seeded teams. Regardless of how you fill out your bracket, be sure to click SUBMIT after you are done to ensure that your bracket is recorded in the system.

HOW DO I GET BONUS BRACKETS FOR ADDITIONAL CHANCES TO WIN?

Guests may earn up to two (2) additional bracket submissions per day between 12:00 AM on March 3, 2026 and 11:59 PM on March 12, 2026 as follows:

- Earn 100 base points in slots and/or Table Games play per day, limit five (5) bonus brackets per guest with rated slot and/or Table Games play.
- Place qualifying wagers of \$100 or more per day, using the Snoqualmie Casino & Hotel Sportsbook application, limit five (5) bonus brackets per guest with sports wagers.

AT WHAT TIME DO EARNING ACTIVITIES RESET EACH DAY?

OFFICIAL RULES

PARTICIPATION

- Participation is free for all Crescent Club members, 21 years of age and older with valid photo ID. Crescent Club membership is free.
- To participate Crescent Club members must first register online by visiting snocasino.pickems.com beginning March 3, 2026 or by accepting an emailed invitation to play.
- Limit one (1) participating account per person and/or email address.
- To register participants must provide identifying information, a valid email address, their unique Crescent Club player card number and must further agree to the promotional terms and conditions.
- All Crescent Club members receive one (1) free bracket submission. No purchases or payments are required to enter or win or claim any prize.
- Guests may earn up to two (2) additional bracket submissions per day between 12:00 AM on March 3, 2026 and 11:59 PM on March 12, 2026 as follows:
 - Earn 100 base points in slots and/or Table Games play. Limit one (1) additional bonus bracket submission per guest per day. Base points must be earned between 12:00 AM and 11:59 PM to qualify. Limit five (5) total brackets per person from this category.
 - Place a qualifying wager of \$100 or more using the Snoqualmie Casino & Hotel Sportsbook mobile application. Limit one (1) additional bonus bracket submission per guest per day. Wager must be placed between 12:00 AM and 11:59 PM to qualify. Limit five (5) total brackets per person from this category.
- All Crescent Club members may participate in this promotion when they download and sign up for a Snoqualmie Sportsbook mobile application account for free.

HOW TO ENTER

- After a Crescent Club member registers, they may proceed to the 'Make Picks' page snocasino.pickems.com and submit their bracket selections anytime during the official entry period from approximately 7:00 PM on Sunday, March 15, 2026 (after the teams are announced) to 11:59 PM on Wednesday, March 18, 2026.
- Registration and bracket selections must be submitted online as outlined herein using a participant's personal mobile device or computer.
- No submissions will be accepted after the deadline for any reason.
- Confirming selections is required by using the submit button at the bottom of the page. Follow all additional instructions listed on the page, observing all posting deadlines.
- Participants may change their selections at any time before clicking on the 'submit' button. Once submitted online selections are final and cannot be changed or altered.
- Complete the entry by filling out the brackets for the four (4) regions and final rounds of the Tournament, making sure to use the submit button. In order to fill out a valid bracket participants must choose a winner for each match-up that is consistent with the prior match-ups.
- Should a tie occur for any prize the tie-breaker will be the date and time of the bracket submission, the earliest submission date and time wins. Should a tie still result after using a date and time tiebreaker a random drawing will be held among all tied participants.



- This promotion will award prizes based on the results of the 2026 NCAA Division I Men's College Basketball Tournament. On March 15, 2026 the Tournament's selection committee will seed the qualifying college basketball teams that will participate in the Tournament.

CONTEST SCHEDULE AND SCORING SYSTEM

- Participants will attempt to select/pick the winning team for each of the games of the Tournament presented in the form of a bracket. Participants will earn points for each winning team correctly picked through their bracket. The number of points awarded will increase with each round of the tournament.
- Only the highest scoring bracket submission will be counted for each participant's final scoring position in the content.

OVERALL MUDDLED MIDDLE WINNER

DAILY INTERACTIVE GAMES

- Crescent Club members may win additional bonus entries into the \$180,000 Cash and FREEPLAY Semi-Final and Final Drawings held on March 29, 2026 when they play any and/or all of the three (3) available interactive games at snocasino.pickems.com. The three (3) of the interactive games below will be available to play each day throughout the promotional period. Limit one (1) gameplay for each available interactive game listed below per day. HOT SHOTS

- Participants play a video arcade-style game and virtually shoot balls into a basket to try to earn points. Participants are awarded between three (3) and seventy-five (75) bonus entries into the drawings.
